Regarding the temporary suspension of its manufacturing plant in the U.S. announced on April 1, 2020, Subaru Corporation will change the previously announced schedule and extend the shutdown of Subaru of Indiana Automotive, Inc. (SIA) in response to decreased vehicle demand in North America and interruptions in our supply chain.

SIA will remain closed through May 8, with plans to resume production on May 11. (Previous schedule: Shutdown through April 17, with plans to reopen on April 20)
