Subaru Temporarily Suspends Part of Operations at its Aerospace Company Manufacturing Facilities in Japan due to COVID-19 Spread (Information as of April 17, 2020, Japan time)

Subaru Corporation announces its Aerospace Company will temporarily suspend production at the Handa Plant and Handa West Plant (Handa City, Aichi Prefecture) from April 20 through May 1.

Subaru manufactures center wing boxes for Boeing at its Handa Plant and Handa West Plant. In response to the temporary suspension of 787 production at Boeing due to the spread of COVID-19, Subaru made the decision to adjust production volume. Production at the Handa plants is currently scheduled to resume on May 11, after the Company's originally scheduled holidays (May 2–10). We will continue to closely communicate with Boeing and take an appropriate approach to production restart.

Subaru will continue production of aircraft parts at its other manufacturing facilities.
